- Work experience/resume, including part-time and full-time jobs
- A college transcript (unofficial is acceptable)
- Letter of referral or recommendation from a college adviser or other journalism faculty member (this may be mailed separately or emailed to jmadden@scpress.org)
- No more than six samples of newspaper work (stories, columns for editorial interns; ad designs for advertising interns; photographs for photography interns). These samples will not be returned.
- List of college activities (clubs, organizations, fraternity/sorority)
- List of any college scholarships or awards received
